*Whaleguide*, developed by Ralf Kiefner, offers everything you need to know about whales and dolphins and much more with effortless navigation and videos heighten to the experience. *Whaleguide* is made primarily for average users so it is easy to read and understand, even though most of the research has come from books by well known cetacean researchers, scientific articles, plus digitized original descriptions.

Providing as much information as a book, but offering much more, *Whaleguide* has a very useful Finder function that makes it very easy to identify a species from just a few details that can be seen from a boat or from shore. In addition the GPS function refines searches and helps to identify the species in real time, showing only the species that may occur at the present location. When you plan your next trip the Finder also shows which whales and dolphins can be found at your choice of holiday destination.

*Whaleguide* has more than 400 photos and more than 50 video clips. The standard version provides the user with more than 200 photos of extraordinary quality. It is possible to buy a photo upgrade with more than 250 images that provide extra angles and close-ups of the different species.

The video upgrade provides a completely new dimension of insight into the behaviour of whales and dolphins, showing how they move, sing, communicate and behave both above and underwater. This video upgrade is a must have.

The iPad and iPhone versions contain the same features and the same amount of photos and videos, but due to the different size of the screen, both versions are slightly different in handling.
